POSTGRADUATE PROGRAMMES

DOCTOR OF PHILOSOPHY

As part of our commitment in becoming a centre of excellence for Islamic business and management education, UUM IBS offers 4 main areas of specialisations as follows:

- i. Muamalat and Syariah Advisory.
- ii. Islamic Economics.
- iii. Islamic Management.
- iv. Islamic Banking and Finance.

Under those specialisations, PhD students may choose to focus their research on various business fields such as Islamic Management, Islamic Finance, Islamic Banking, Syariah Issue (Muamalat), Islamic Economics, Islamic Accounting, Islamic Insurance (Takaful), Islamic Marketing, Zakat Management, Mirath Management (Inheritance), Islamic Entrepreneurship, and Islamic Human Resource Management.

MASTER BY COURSEWORK

MIFB (Master in Islamic Finance and Banking)

Master in Islamic Finance and Banking (MIFB) programme is offered starting from September 2012 by Islamic Business School (UUM IBS). This programme is a course work based programme developed to produce graduates who can work independently, skilled, competent, creative and innovative with in-depth knowledge in their related areas of research and are able to contribute to the body of knowledge. At the end of this course, students are required to complete a research paper in their field of study that will further enhance their analytical, writing and communication skills.

MIBS (Master of Islamic Business Studies)

The programme aims to produce business leaders with Islamic values who are capable of contributing to the development of Shariah-based business. Throughout the programme students will be exposed to the Islamic concepts, principles, and ethics in solving business management issues faced by ummah in realizing global prosperity and well-being. At the end of this course, students are required to complete a research paper in their field of study that will further enhance their analytical, writing and communication skills.

MASTER BY RESEARCH

Islamic Business School (IBS) also offers the following programmes:

- i. Master of Science (Islamic Finance) by research.
- ii. Master of Science (Islamic Banking) by research.
- iii. Master of Islamic Business Studies (MIBS) by research.

These programmes are offered on a full-time and a part-time basis. Full-time students are to complete their study between 3 to 6 semesters, and those on part-time basis shall complete between 4 to 10 semesters.

UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMMES

BACHELOR OF ISLAMIC FINANCE AND BANKING WITH HONOURS - BIFB (HONS)

This programme aims to produce competent and conversant workforce in the area of Islamic banking and finance to meet market demand in both national and international level. Career prospects in this industry include Finance and Islamic Banking institutions as well as other institutions which offer and practice Islamic concepts/principles as a way of conducting business. The structure of the programme is specifically designed to include vital aspects of both Islamic and conventional finance and banking coupled with other relevant fields to strengthen the knowledge in meeting growing demand by the industry.

BACHELOR OF MUAMALAT ADMINISTRATION WITH HONOURS - BMA (HONS)
